The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is in receipt of your application for notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 98-10 for the above referenced product. The Biopesticides and Pollution Prevention Division (BPPD) has conducted a review of this request for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the action requested falls within the scope of PRN 98-10.

The labeling submitted with this application has been stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records. The alternate brand names "GO AWAY! DEER & RABBIT REPPELLENT READY TO SPRAY" and BONIDE GO AWAY! DEER & RABBIT REPELLENT READY TO SPRAY" have been added to the product's records. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling with the modifications.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to your company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) and is subject to review by the EPA. If the website is false or misleading, the product will be considered to be misbranded and sale or distribution of the product is unlawful under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR § 156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements the EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product may be toxic to aquatic organisms. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area. Rinsing application equipment over the treated area will help avoid run off to water bodies or drainage systems.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For residential use only on home lawns, flower and vegetables gardens, fruit, nut and ornamental trees, and wooden structures and fences around the home.

Deer, Rabbit and Tree Squirrels: Shot-Gun Hot Pepper Wax Animal Repellent Concentrate repels deer, rabbits and tree squirrels from the following fruits and vegetables: citrus fruits, root and tuber vegetables, bulb vegetables, leafy vegetables, brassica (cole) leafy vegetables, legume vegetables, fruiting vegetables and cucurbit vegetables. It also can be used on all indoor and outdoor ornamental plants and wooden structures and fences.

ALL USES: Apply Shot-Gun Hot Pepper Wax Animal Repellent Concentrate using [attached sprayer] spray equipment. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Mixing, Application and Retreatment Directions for Plants: Apply Shot-Gun Hot Pepper Wax Animal Repellent Concentrate as diluted below, as a foliar spray to the leaves, stems, fruits, and flowers of the plant until wet. Do not drench roots in soil or media. Do not apply when rain is expected within 24 hours.

Initial rate is 1 part Shot-Gun Hot Pepper Wax Animal Repellent Concentrate to 16 parts WATER (8 fl. oz. or 16 Tbs. per gallon of water). Apply until foliage is wet or a maximum of 3 gallons prepared solution per 1000 square feet. Repeat application in 3-7 days, for 2-3 weeks, until control is established. ONCE CONTROL IS ESTABLISHED use MAINTENANCE rate of 1 part Shot-Gun Hot Pepper Wax Animal Repellent Concentrate to 32 parts WATER (4 fl. oz. or 8 Tbs. per gallon of water) every 2-4 weeks, as necessary to maintain control.

Mixing, Application, and Retreatment Directions for Wooden Structures and Fences: Mix 8 fluid ounces (16 Tbs.), per gallon of water. Apply until surface is wet. Repeat application if necessary in 1 to 2 weeks, until control is established. Once control is established, apply every 6 to 8 weeks to previously sprayed surfaces.

[Hose-End Sprayer Instructions:]

HOW TO USE

Make sure water control knob on hose sprayer is in the "OFF" position. Hold by handle and shake vigorously, turning bottle as you shake. Attach hose to spray nozzle. Bend safety tab back and break off. Turn control to "WATER" position. Slowly turn on water supply to moderate rate of flow. Point nozzle toward spray area, turn control knob to "ON". Product will automatically mix with the water. Slowly sweep the area to be treated. To stop spraying, turn control valve to "OFF" position. Turn off water at faucet. To relieve pressure, turn control valve to the "WATER" position pointing sprayer away from self. Remove from hose.

[Hose-End Sprayer Instructions:]

TWIST & SHOOTTM READY-TO-SPRAY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Make sure control knob is in "OFF" position, then connect to garden hose.
- 2) Turn water on at faucet. When spraying low growing plants and small shrubs, twist the control knob right, to the "FAN" position. When spraying taller trees, shrubs and other plants, twist the control knob left to the "STREAM" position for extended reach and more uniform coverage. The product mixes automatically with the water as you spray.
- 3) To stop spraying, turn the control knob lever to the "OFF" position. Turn off water at the faucet and disconnect sprayer from garden hose.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store and transport in an upright position. Store in a cool dry area inaccessible to children or pets. **Disposal:** *If empty*: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. *If partly filled*: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
