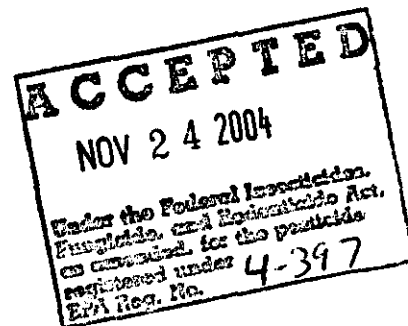

Hot Pepper Wax Ready-For-Use can be used on fruits, vegetables, citrus, root crops, legumes, indoor/outdoor ornamentals, and grasses.

APPLICATION AND TIMING: *SHAKE WELL*; Apply until foliage or surface is wet. Repeat application in 3-7 days for 2-3 weeks, until control is established. **ONCE CONTROL IS ESTABLISHED**, use every 2-4 weeks, as necessary to maintain control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store and transport in an upright position. Store in a cool dry area inaccessible to children or pets.
