2. Use Enclosure 1 as a guide to revising your "FIRST AID" text.
3. Delete the redundant sentence below your "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" text: "For information ... at 1-800-858-7378".

FIRST AID	
Have label with you when obtaining treatment advice, including 1-800-858-7378 ¹ .	
If swallowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. •Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. •Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.
If on skin or clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Take off contaminated clothing. •Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. •Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Bonide Rabbit Scat works on the principle of taste repellency. Rabbits do not like the taste of foliage of plants protected with this material.

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MIXING DIRECTIONS:

1. As A Dust. Do not mix. Use without dilution.
2. As A Spray. Paste the dust with a small amount of water and then dilute as follows:

<u>Amount of Dust</u>	<u>Amount of Water</u>
6 ounces	2½ gallons
4 teaspoons	1 pint

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

When damage has been observed or is anticipated by the presence of rabbits, apply product as a dust or spray.

1. As A Dust. Using a hand duster or simply squeezing the plastic bottle, dust foliage uniformly.
2. As A Spray. Using a sprayer of proper size, apply product as diluted above to all leaf surfaces to point of runoff.

RE-APPLICATION:

Repeat application after rains or any appreciable new growth of plant.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store and transport in an upright position. Store in a cool dry area inaccessible to children or pets.

Disposal: *If empty* – Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. *If partly filled* – Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
