The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin and Tetramethrin Interim Decisions, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. Do not apply directly to or near water. Drift and run-off may be hazardous to fish in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment, washwater, or rinsate. See Directions for Use for additional precautions and requirements. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are foraging the treatment area.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Combustible. Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not apply this product in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Do not use on surfaces that can be harmed or stained by water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For both indoor and outdoor use.

Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared, processed, served or stored.

Use Restrictions:

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated. Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated article until spray has dried. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application. Not for use in outdoor residential misting systems. For surface spray use: Do not allow adults, children or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Do not apply when food is present. Not for broadcast use on indoor residential surfaces.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

<u>Pesticide Storage:</u> Store and transport in an upright position. Store in a cool dry area inaccessible to children or pets.

Do not puncture or incinerate!

Pesticide Disposal & Container Handling: *If empty* – Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. *If partly filled* – Do not pour or dispose down-the-drain or sewer. Call your local solid waste Agency for disposal options.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

INDOORS: CLUSTER FLIES, HOUSEFLIES, FRUIT FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, BEES, BLACK FLIES, SKIPPER FLIES, BLOW FLIES, AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 – 10 seconds for average room. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources, which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Leave room and keep door closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects.

COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, SCORPIONS, SPIDERS (except black widow and brown recluse species),

No. 4-NY-1 Page 3 of 6 Pages MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS, STINK BUGS, ASIAN LADY BEETLES, BOXELDER BUGS, FLEAS, EARWIGS, PANTRY PESTS (GRAIN BEETLES, CLUSTER FLIES, CLOVER MITES) AND PILLBUGS: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible.

CARPET BEETLES: Apply as a spot or crack-and-crevice spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets.

BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Apply as a spot or crack-and-crevice to treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

To control **Clothes Moths** and **Carpet Beetles** on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use. Dry clean treated clothes before wearing.

OUTDOORS:

Use Restrictions: Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors, and/or mists have dispersed. Do not use on edible crops. Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use or for commercial seed production or for research purposes.

All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

- 1) Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
- 2) Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch or lawn);
- 3) Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level:
- 4) Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application. Do not apply when windspeed is greater than 15 mph.

Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (e.g., 2 ft x 1 ft or 4 ft x 0.5 ft.)

For soil or foliar applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds. Do not apply the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to an area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application. Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment. Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff.

Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff. To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

Pests on Outside Surfaces of Buildings: For control of building infestation due to Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, Stink Bugs, Asian Lady Beetles, Boxelder Bugs and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance, up to a height of 3 feet. Apply as a spot or crack-and-crevice spray to outside surface of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to) screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps.

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Hornets and Yellow Jackets. Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, Cockroaches, including Asian Cockroaches, Crickets, Mole Crickets, Centipedes, and Silverfish. Hold can two (2) to three (3) feet from surface to be treated and spray on infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Spray to slightly moisten the surface. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant trails and hills.

ANTS, LONE STAR TICKS, CRICKETS, FLEAS AND EARWIGS: Apply thoroughly to infestations in bushes, grass or weeds. For Ants, spray around ant trails and hills.

FOR CONTROL OF ORNAMENTAL GARDEN INSECTS: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill Japanese Beetles hit by spray, as well as Whiteflies, Aphids, Exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites, Stink bugs, and Leafminers.

May be used on plants, as well as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas. May also be used on other plants such as African Violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, geraniums, crassula, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering Jew and zinnias.

Effective when used as directed against Whiteflies, Aphids, Spider and Red Mites, Exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Japanese Beetles, Pavement Ants, Clover Mites and Armyworms. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Spray in one second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90°F. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as infestations occur.
