The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the permethrin, piperonyl butoxide (PBO) and tetramethrin REDs, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed along with copies of the acute toxicity and product chemistry reviews completed for the subject product. Products shipped

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after 12 months from the date of this amendment or the next printing of the label whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. CAUTION

Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops while bees are actively visiting the treatment area.

FIRST AID

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use Restrictions

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use.

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Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed or served.

Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Do not apply this product with a sponge. Do not wet articles to the point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated article until spray has dried. Do not apply as a broadcast to indoor surfaces at residential sites.

OUTDOORS:

Spray Applications – [Affix trigger sprayer to bottle. Turn nozzle to on position.] [Use pump-up or other mechanical sprayer. Do not dilute this product.] Point sprayer away from face. For best results, spray when air is calm. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing. Spray surface until slightly wet (at a rate of 4 ounces of product to treat approximately 25 square feet of surface area.) Repeat treatment when insects return, but not more than once per week.

Do not use on edible crops.

Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain. All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

- (1) Treatment to soil or vegetation around structures;
- (2) Applications to lawns, turf, and other vegetation;
- (3) Applications to building foundations, up to a maximum height of 3 feet.

Other than applications to building foundations, all outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors, and eave) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications only. Not for use in outdoor residential misting systems.

Pests on Outside Surfaces of Buildings: For control of building infestations of *ants, clover mites, crickets, earwigs, millipedes and sowbugs (pillbugs)*, spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance up to a height of 3 feet. Apply as a spot or crack-and-crevice spray to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps. Repeat treatment if insects return but not more than once per week.

Crawling insects: *ants, cockroaches, crickets and silverfish*, hold sprayer two (2) to three (3) feet from surface to be treated and apply as a spot or crack-and crevice spray to lightly moisten infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs.

Ants, lone star ticks, deer ticks, crickets, fleas & earwigs: Apply thoroughly to infestation in bushes, grass or weeds. For *ants*, spray on and around hills and trails until damp. Spray nests hidden under steps, brickwork and concrete. Break apart accessible nests and spray on and around debris.

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Flying insects: *flies, mosquitoes & gnats*: Apply as a spot or crack-and-crevice spray around areas of entry such as doors and window frames. Also spray areas of infestation around garbage and refuse.

Wasps, hornets, yellow jackets & bees: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Point spray opening away from face. Aim spray at nest openings in bushes, under eaves, chimneys, cracks & crevices. Thoroughly saturate nest with spray, contacting as many insects as possible.

INDOORS:

Spray Applications – [Affix trigger sprayer to bottle. Turn nozzle to on position.] [Use pump-up or other mechanical sprayer. Do not dilute this product.] Point spray away from face. Spray surface until slightly wet (at a rate of 4 ounces of product to treat approximately 25 square feet of surface area.) Repeat treatment when insects return, but not more than once per week.

Cockroaches, ants, boxelder bugs, crickets, dermestids, firebrats, fleas, palmetto bugs, silverfish, sowbugs, ticks & waterbugs: Apply to all areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially in cracks and crevices and hidden areas around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers and bookcases. When pests are driven out, spray directly.

Ants: Spray around ant trails, doors and windows where ants enter premises.

Carpenter Ants: For effective control, locate and treat nests and surrounding areas. Apply around doors and windows where ants enter premises and where they crawl and hide. Spray into infested wood through existing openings.

Fleas & Ticks: Apply in infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, and between and under cushions of upholstered furniture where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Do not use directly on pets. For best results, pets should be treated with an appropriate flea and/or tick control product registered for use on pets before allowing them to return to the treated area.

Spiders: Apply along and behind baseboards, to window and door frames, corners, pipes, storage localities, and crawl spaces over which these pests may crawl. Also spray webbing contacting spiders directly where possible.

Earwigs, ground beetles, millipedes, mole crickets, pillbugs, sowbugs, scorpions & ticks: Apply around doors and windows where these pests may enter premises. Treat baseboards and storage areas where these pests are found.

PANTRY PESTS – *grain beetles, flour beetles, cigarette beetles, clover mites, cluster flies, drugstore beetles, elmleaf beetles, rice weevils, lesser grain borers, spider beetles, & tobacco moths*: Treat exposed stages. Remove all foodstuffs, utensils and shelf paper from area to be treated. Discard used shelf paper and any infested foodstuffs. Apply spray to shelves and in cracks and crevices behind and under cupboards and cabinets. Allow spray to dry prior to replacement of shelf paper, food and utensils.

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Carpet beetles: Spray on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets where these insects are found.

Webbing clothes moths: Use this product as a crack and crevice treatment in closets and storage areas where these pests are found. This is an adjunct treatment and will not control moth larvae already on clothes. Do not apply to clothing.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from children.

Pesticide Disposal: If partly filled – Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

Container Disposal: If empty – Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
