- Purpose** The purpose of this submission is to revise your label according to our letter above and to revise your Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) to reflect your recent transfer of this product from Faesy & Bestoff to Bonide Products.
- Label** The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product.
 - 1. The correct spelling and format of the names of your target species are as follows: domestic dogs (*Canis l. familiaris*) and eastern cottontail rabbits (*Sylvilagus floridanus*). The scientific name of the domestic dog is optional.
- Existing stocks** Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.
- Consequence for non-compliance** If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

CSF Your revised CSF dated September 16, 2006, is acceptable. All other versions are obsolete. We have placed a copy in our files for this product.

Use Restrictions: This product may be used to discourage domestic dogs (*Canis Familiaris*) from defecating on or near treated lawns or in treated areas around ornamental plants, trees, shrubs, and pavements. This product also may be used to repel cottontail rabbits (*Sylvilagus Floridanus*) from entering, feeding in, or defecating within treated areas associated with flower gardens, ornamental plants, trees, and shrubs.

DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT IN VEGETABLE GARDENS NOR ON FOOD CROPS, MAY BE USED AROUND THE PERIMETER OF VEGETABLE GARDENS. DO NOT ALLOW THE PRODUCT TO WIND DRIFT TO NEARBY FOOD CROPS.

Application Directions: Before treatment, try to remove all traces of animal droppings and urine from the areas to be protected. Animals are attracted by the odors of these deposits. If the odors are effectively removed, regular use of Bonide Rabbit & Dog Chaser around ornamental and shrubs should discourage new defecations by dogs and visitations by rabbits.
