For use outdoors, on lawns and as a barrier band treatment around house foundation. Kills ants (including Fire Ants), armyworms (Fall and Yellow-striped), billbugs, chinch bugs, crickets, cutworms, earwigs, European crane flies, fleas, grubs, roaches (German and American), sod webworms, ticks and other insect pests listed on this label.

To use this product follow these 3 easy steps -(1) Determine the size of the job and measure the area to be treated. (2) Determine the proper setting for your spreader using the spreader setting chart. (3) Treat as directed in rate chart. Complete coverage is important. Water in granules immediately following application.
