The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Lambda-Cyhalothrin Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for

shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

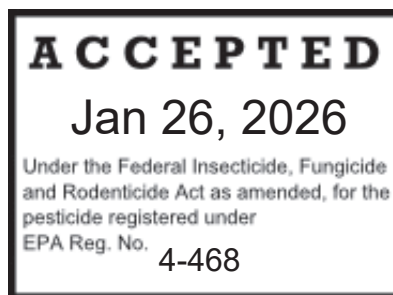

Do not apply directly to residential lawns and turf in residential settings (e.g., homes, parks, schools, athletic fields or any other area frequented by the general public).

Keep children or pets off treated area until product has been watered in and is dry.

Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2 ft. by 1 ft. or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.).

For soil applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.

In New York State, this product may not be applied to an area within 100 ft. of a coastal marsh, or stream that drains directly into a coastal marsh.

Do not apply the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. For use outdoors as a barrier band treatment around house foundation. Kills ants (including Fire Ants), crickets, earwigs, fleas, roaches (German and American), and other insect pests listed on this label.

To use this product follow these 3 easy steps – (1) Determine the size of the job and measure the area to be treated. (2) Determine the proper setting for your spreader using the spreader setting chart. (3) Treat as directed in rate chart. Complete coverage is important. Water in granules immediately following application.
