The Agency recently completed an audit of the regulatory file for EPA Reg. No. 4-485 (BONIDE® SUF 15), and has determined that an updated has not yet been submitted in response to the Notice of Registration of December 2, 2010 (copy enclosed). As such, you must incorporate the following changes into the subject label:

General Comment(s):

1. Within the subject label, change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 4-485"

Ingredient Statement section comment(s):

- 3. To facilitate inclusion of required label language from the RED for piperonyl butoxide, you must revise the 1st footnote to read "*(butylcarbityl)(6-propylpiperonyl) ether and related compounds"

Precautionary Statements, First Aid subsection comment(s):

4. To facilitate inclusion of missing/required label language from the acute toxicology review that was completed for this product, you must revise the 2nd sentence within the "HOTLINE NUMBER" subsection to read "For additional information on this pesticide product (including health concerns, medical emergencies or pesticide incidents), you may call the National Pesticide Information Center at 1-800-858-7378 from 6:30 AM to 4:30 PM Pacific Time. After 4:30 PM Pacific Time, you may call your local poison control center."

Within 45 days of the date of this letter, you must submit a new label as an amendment to effectively incorporate the referenced label revisions. If we do not receive an amended label, the Agency may pursue further regulatory action, including cancellation under section 6 of FIFRA. - Do not use this product indoors or in enclosed areas.
- Do not apply to any one area more than 1 time per day.
- Do not enter or allow others to enter until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the treated area during application.
- Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors and/or mists have dispersed, and until sprays have dried.

CRICKETS, SILVERFISH	Apply this product undiluted, using a tank sprayer or hand trigger sprayer capable of delivering a coarse droplet spray. Treat a band of soil 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the exterior building foundation. Treat the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where pests are active and may find entrance. Apply as a course spray to thoroughly and uniformly wet the treated areas. One quart will treat 125 sq ft of surface area.

Do not re-apply more than 1 time per day.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep this product in its tightly closed original container, when not in use, away from direct sunlight, and protected from freezing. Store and transport this product in an upright position, in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area that is inaccessible to children and animals.
