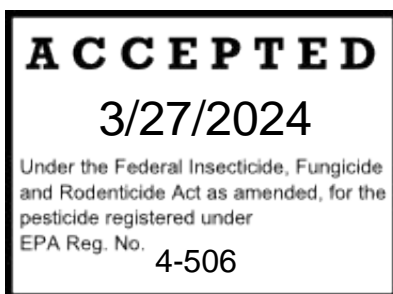

#### **What does the product do?**

[BON G/I] [This product] kills unwanted weeds, grasses and plants for up to [12 months][1 year]. Use this product to kill unwanted vegetation on driveways, walkways, parking areas, sidewalks, patios, gravel areas, rock landscapes, under fences and around curbs. Use in areas where no vegetation growth is desired for up to [12 months][1 year]. [Product name] [This product] starts working as soon as it contacts the plant and weeds begin to turn yellow and wilt within 3-5 days. Complete kill occurs in 1 to 2 weeks.

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Residential Use Only.

**READ ALL DIRECTIONS COMPLETELY BEFORE USE.**

Shake well before use.

#### **USE RESTRICTIONS:**

- **DO NOT** apply this product through any type of irrigation system.
- **DO NOT** apply directly to or allow drift to contact desirable plants.
- This product must only be applied as a ground spot treatment.
- **DO NOT** apply near bodies of water including, fish pools, ponds, lakes or streams.
- **DO NOT** apply over the roots systems of desirable plants. For trees and shrubs **DO NOT** apply closer than twice the distance from the trunk to the drip line as roots may be within this area.
- **DO NOT** apply to slopes in landscape as movement on soil surfaces may damage desirable plants down slope.
- **DO NOT** apply next to a fence if desirable vegetation is growing on the other side, or if future planting is intended within one year.
- **DO NOT** use before planting lawns, fruits, vegetables, flowers, or other plants because this product remains active in soil for up to one year. In soils with heavy clay, weed control may exceed one year.
- **DO NOT** use on desirable lawns.
- **DO NOT** apply to powdery, dry or light sandy soils when the soil may be blown by wind. If necessary soil surface must be settled by rain or irrigation.
- **DO NOT** apply more than 9.37 fl. oz. of product (0.34 lbs. glufosinate-ammonium, 0.002 lbs. imazapyr) per 1000 sq. ft. in any single application.
- **DO NOT** apply more than 9.37 fl. oz. of product (0.34 lbs. glufosinate-ammonium, 0.002 lbs. imazapyr) per 1,000 sq. ft. per year.
- **DO NOT** apply more than 1 applications per year when using the maximum single application rate.

#### **WHERE TO USE:**

Use outdoors on driveways, walkways, parking areas, sidewalks, patios, gravel areas, rock landscapes, under fences and around curbs.

**WHEN TO APPLY:**

Apply when weeds are actively growing. [Use anytime weeds and grasses are actively growing.] For best [fastest visual] results, apply during warm, sunny weather [above 60° F] [to accelerate systemic movement of the product from foliage to roots.] Apply when air is calm to prevent drift to desirable plants.

**RAINPROOF Protection:** Rain or watering 4 hours after application will NOT wash away effectiveness. [Apply when weeds are small and before seeds form.]

**AMOUNT TO MIX:****For General Annual Weed Control:**

- Add 3-9 fl. oz. (6 to 18 tablespoons[TBS]) per gallon of water to treat target weeds in 1,000 sq. ft. Use the higher rate for larger weeds. Use lower rate for easy to kill weeds such as (small) seedlings.

**For Brush, Vines, Woody Plants, Perennials and other tough established weeds:**

- Add 6-9 fl. oz. (12 to 18 TBS) per gallon of water to treat target weeds in 1,000 sq. ft. Use the higher rate for larger, well established vegetation.

**HOW TO APPLY:**

- Using a lawn & garden tank sprayer, apply as a spot or directed spray to weeds, grasses and any undesirable vegetation. Spray the plants you want to kill until they are thoroughly wet.
- [To achieve maximum control of new weeds, use a sprinkling can and apply evenly over target weeds, allowing application to soak into ground.]
- When spot treating weeds around desirable plants, shield plants from drift with a sheet [piece] of cardboard or plastic.
- Avoid product runoff to nearby desirable plants. Ensure uniform and complete coverage. Use a coarse spray.
- If desirable plants are accidentally sprayed, rinse off immediately with water [or cut off treated area].
- Clean sprayer after use. Rinse sprayer and all sprayer parts with water 3 [three] times. Spray rinse water on bare soil or gravel.
- **DO NOT** spray during windy conditions.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not spray plants or grasses you like because they will die. Do not use on lawns.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**
