DIRECTIONS

URINALS AND TOILETS—Should be cleaned daily with a solution of 1/2 pt. disinfectant to 10 qts. of water. When finished pour the solution down drains to thoroughly clean and deodorize them.

PUBLIC PLACES—Wash thoroughly with a solution of 1-100, so as to cover all possible areas of infection. For use in schools, institutions, public buildings, colleges, etc.

OUTDOOR RECEPTACLES—Garbage pails: Wash with a 1-100 solution.

STABLES—Use a 1-100 solution. Be sure dirt is all removed and then spray entire infected area.

CLOSET BOWLS, TOILET BOWLS—Clean and flush the bowl each day with a solu-

tion 1-100. This solution should also be used to wash the seat.

CUSPIDORS—Clean with a 1-100 solution and leave a little in the receptacle to disinfect and deodorize.

CHICKEN COOPS, SLAUGHTER HOUSES—Clean and thoroughly wash with a 1-100 solution, coops, vats, floors, etc. Pour down drain to deodorize.

FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING
CLEANING—Dilute 1 part disinfectant to 100 parts of water. Wash floors and use for deodorizing sinks, refrigerators, etc.
DEODORIZER—Add 2 ounces to regular scrubbing solution, use for floors, sinks, woodwork, etc.
