In order to protect the public, the Secretary, on his own motion, may at any time cancel the registration of an economic poison and, in lieu thereof, issue a registration under protest, in accordance with Section 4(c) of the Act. *In no event shall registration of an article, whether or not protested, be construed as a defense for the commission of any offense prohibited under Section 3 of the Act.* The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by a trademark held by others.

Blue Dragon Dust is used for the control of the Mexican Bean Beetle and certain other insects.

Directions

Do not mix the contents of this package with any other material but apply to the plant with a dust gun just as it comes from the package. For an average dusting about three 4-lb. packages are required for one acre. If a liquid spray is desired, add one pound of Blue Dragon Dust ~~per~~ to four gallons of water. Stir well and spray with a good liquid spray gun which will force the mist on the under side of the leaves. CAUTION: Dusting or spraying should be done when air is quiet. (Avoid contact with eyes, nose and throat. *(Put in CAUTION SECTION)*)

Blue Dragon Dust is used for the control of the Mexican Bean Beetle and certain other insects.

Some of the used of Blue Dragon Dust:

Mexican Bean Beetle- Dust of spray leaves as soon as the adult beetle appears. Repeat application when necessary.

Bean Leaf Beetle - Apply same as for Mexican Bean Beetle.
ON CUCUMBERS

Cucumber Beetle - Striped and spotted beetles. Dust leaves thoroughly. Begin early and repeat as necessary.

Squash Bugs - For summer squash. Dust thoroughly at 7 - 10 day intervals when insects or damage appears.

Potato Beetle - LeafHoppers and Flea Beetles on potatoes. Dust when insects appear. Repeat application at 7-10day intervals if needed.

Corn Earworm - Apply 2 to 3 day intervals when first silks appear. Continue until silk begins to dry.

Tomato Hornworm - Fruit worm- Fall Army Worm - Stink bug, Dust *ON TOMATOES* *EGGPLANTS* *PEPPERS* thoroughly 7 to 10 day intervals when insects or damage appears.

Flea Beetle - On cucumber, summer squash, potatoes, tomatoes, eggplants and pepper. Dust when insects or damage appears. Repeat application at 7 to 10 day intervals if needed.

~~Cattle Lice - Dust over the animal and rub thoroughly into skin. Apply weekly if needed.~~

~~Dog & Cat~~ *Cat* - Ticks, Fleas, and Lice. Dust liberally over the animal and rub thoroughly into skin. Dust in and around sleeping quarters and other areas where ticks, fleas and lice occur. Repeat, as necessary. *NOT MORE THAN ONCE WEEKLY*
