Use Restrictions: For use on home vegetables and ornamentals only.

Mixing: Do not mix the contents of this package in water.

Application Method: Apply a thin, uniform covering to the upper and lower leaf surfaces with a garden hand duster. One pound treats approximately 400 linear feet of row.

BEANS: To control Mexican Bean Beetle, Bean Leaf Beetle, Cucumber Beetle, Flea Beetle, Thrips, Twelvespotted Beetle, dust as the adult beetles appear. Repeat application as necessary.

CUCUMBERS, PUMPKINS, SQUASH: Apply as directed above to control <u>Cucumber Beetle</u>. Begin early and repeat as necessary. To control <u>Squash Vine Borer</u> on pumpkins and squash, apply once or twice a week to stems and vines at base of plants.

BROCCOLI, CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, CARROTS, COLLARDS, KALE, TURNIPS, MUSTARD GREENS: Apply as directed above to control <u>Vegetable Weevil</u>, <u>Imported Cabbageworm</u>.

ASPARAGUS: Apply as directed above, as soon as larvae appear, to control Asparagus Beetle.

SWEET CORN: To control <u>European Corn Borer</u>, make the first application as soon as young borers appear on leaves. Start applications in late May or early June for first brood, and in late July or early August for second brood. Make four applications at exactly five day intervals. Direct the dust downward into the whorls or crowns and leaf axils.

POTATOES: Apply as directed above to control Potato Beetle, as soon as larvae begin feeding.

FLOWERS & SHRUBS: To control many external leaf-chewing insects, apply as soon as insects appear and repeat at weekly intervals as long as the insects continue to appear. Examples of the types of insects that may be controlled are <u>Cabbage Looper</u> on carnation. chrysanthemum and geranium; <u>Flea Beetle</u> on petunia and primrose; <u>Imported Cabbageworm</u> on nasturtium, mignonette and sweet alyssum; <u>Rose Chafer</u> on rose and peony; <u>Asiatic Garden Beetle</u> on petunia, phlox and rose.
