## DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DRAGON DIPEL® WETTABLE**, unlike chemical insecticides, can be used anytime caterpillars (leaf-eating worms) appear in trees or vegetables. Pets and family can return to the yard or garden immediately after spraying. Vegetables may be picked and consumed anytime after spraying. The active ingredient, *Bacillus thuringiensis*, has been commercially proven to selectively affect only leaf-eating caterpillars, nothing else. Lady beetles, earthworms, honey bees, and other beneficial insects are not harmed, so spray coverage can be complete, without worry.

**DRAGON DIPEL® WETTABLE** is easy to mix and apply with regular sprayers. Place half the required amount of water in tank or jar, add recommended amount of **DRAGON DIPEL® WETTABLE**, shake or stir, add balance of water and mix. Do not store diluted spray more than 12 hours.

Since **DRAGON DIPEL® WETTABLE** works only in a caterpillar's stomach, a small amount of treated leaf must be eaten to provide a lethal dose. Complete spray coverage of both sides of foliage is necessary. After biting treated portion of leaf, caterpillars stop feeding within a few hours. Death follows in a few days.

Apply when caterpillars (or their damage) first appear. Re-treatment at 7 to 10 day intervals may be required, especially as egg hatch may occur over an extended period of time. Use of the higher number of recommended tablespoons per gallon of spray provides a longer period of control.
