Subject: Amendment - Revise per Agency letter dated October 1, 1990 Dragon 5% Diazinon Granules EPA Req. No. 16-119 Your submission dated November 27, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with a registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable and a stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

Since our last letter to you regarding this product, the Agency has completed its review of various data submitted by Ciba-Geigy in response to the Diazinon Registration Standard, including the product specific toxicology data that you are relying on to support reregistration of your product. Based on the results of the Agency's reviews, the following revisions should be made at the next label printing or no later than the August 31, 1992 released for shipment deadline stipulated in the Diazinon Registration Standard, as amended:

1) The labeling for the subject product must include a limitation to home lawn and home garden use (i.e., use sites not triggering the Restricted Use classification). The following clarification of the intended use sites must be added to the front panel (an appropriate location would be beneath "Treats up to 5,000 square feet"):

For outdoor use on the home lawn and in the home garden only

2) As an adjunct to the above, to prevent possible misinterpretation of the intended use site, the beginning of the first sentence of the directions for use against fire ants should be revised to read: "To aid in the control of fire ants in home lawns and other outdoor home recreation areas,".

- 3) Since the label will now specifically limit use to the home lawn and the home garden (item "1", above), delete the "Note" about commercially-grown potatoes, which currently appears at the end of the directions for use against wireworms.
- 4) The "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" text should be revised to read as follows:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye injury. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not store near food or feed products. Food utensils such as spoons or measuring cups must not be used for food purposes after use in measuring pesticides. Do not contaminate ornamental fish ponds. Do not allow children or pets on treated areas until granules have been watered into the soil and the grass or soil is dry.

5) Revise the "If on skin" advice in the "Statement of Practical Treatment" to read as follows:

If on skin: Wash promptly with plenty of soap and water. Rinse thoroughly. Get medical attention.

6) In keeping with a recent policy decision, please replace "Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (including swamps, bogs, marshes. and potholes)." with "Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark.".

Labeling released for shipment after the August 31, 1992 deadline imposed by the Diazinon Registration Standard, as amended, must bear the above revisions. Your label should not include the quotation marks that appear around text specified in this letter. Please submit five copies of the revised label when it becomes available.
