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BENOMYL is a systemic fungicide recommended for the control of listed lawn diseases. LAWN & TURF GRASSES

For Dollar Spot and Large Brown Patch, apply at the rate of 2 oz. (12 level Tbs.) per 1,000 sq. ft. in sufficient water to obtain thorough coverage — usually 2 to 5 gals. per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply at earliest appearance of disease and continue at 10 to 14 day intervals as long as needed. When conditions are unusually favorable for development of disease, reduce intervals to 5 to 7 days. Do not graze or feed clippings from treated areas to livestock.

Do not mix Benomyl with lime or alkaline pesticides such as Bordeaux mixture or Lime Sulfur.
