Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

To kill Ants, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Pillbugs, Silverfish, Spiders and Waterbugs indoors.

WHERE TO USE: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to areas where insects are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, under carpets, along baseboards and door sills and frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

HOW TO USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING! For direct application to carpet or furniture, spray an inconspicuous area to check for possible staining or discoloration. Hold can upright, direct spray nozzle toward the surface to be treated and press down. Do not use as a space spray.

To kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks indoors.

WHERE TO USE: Spray the entire floor and carpet area. Special attention should be given to cracks, crevices and under carpet and rug edges. Also treat animal sleeping quarters, closets, upholstered furniture (with particular attention to seams), under sofas and other furniture. Do not use in nurseries or any area where infants may sleep. DO NOT TREAT ANIMALS WITH THIS PRODUCT.

HOW TO USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING! Clean premises thoroughly before treatment. Spray an inconspicuous area of furniture, carpet or flooring to check for possible staining or discoloration. Hold can upright, direct spray nozzle toward the surface to be treated and press down. Do not use as a space spray. In animal sleeping quarters, bedding should be cleaned or replaced with resh bedding. Application should be repeated as necessary. Keep humans and pets off treated surfaces until dry. To

avoid reinfestation, pets must be treated simultaneously with a registered insecticide labeled for use on animals.

FOR OUTDOOR RESIDENTIAL USE

To control Flies, Gnats, Hornets, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Wasps and Yellow Jackets. WHERE TO USE: Use on outdoor surfaces of window and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, partitions and in garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and Mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed.
