c. Under Directions For Use delete "For Fleas and Ticks, use one 6 ounce can for every 1,500 cubic feet of room space." This ~~is~~ inconsistent with using only one can per room. Also delete the phrase "Do not use fogger in area less than 1,000 cubic feet."

d. Delete "offices" under Where to Use since this is not a residential site.

3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

WHEN TO USE: Use when insects are observed or suspected to be present **DRAGON® Indoor Insect Fogger** will kill the following hidden or exposed insect pests Ants, Booklice, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Confused Flour Beetles, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Fleas (adult and larvae), Flies, Fruit Flies, Gnats, Grasshoppers, Hornets, House Flies, Midges, Millipedes, Mole Crickets, Mosquitoes, Palmetto Bugs, Pillbugs, Rice Weevils, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Scorpions, Silverfish, Small Flying Moths, Sowbugs, Spiders, Stable Flies (Dog Flies), Ticks, Wasps, Waterbugs and Yellow Jackets

HOW TO USE:

PREPARING AREA: Open cupboards, cabinets, and doors to area to be treated Close all outside doors and windows Turn off all fans, air conditioning and electrical appliances Put out all flames except pilot lights (keep can at least 6' away from pilot lights) Remove pets, birds, and tightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums before spraying Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (newspapers may be used) Remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils or food preparation equipment All food handling surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using Place can in the middle of the room on a stand, table or place on the floor Place several layers of newspapers under the can to prevent marring of surface Do not use fogger in an area less than 100 cubic feet

Note: Certain types of plastics may be affected by this product Place newspapers over plastic items such as plastic furniture, stereo covers, eyeglasses, etc

ACTIVATING FOGGER: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING Point top of can away from face and eyes Keep at arm's length when activating To activate, depress tab on top of aerosol until locked Place activated fogger on newspaper, leave room and close door Do not re-enter the treated area for at least 2 hours After re-entry, open all doors and windows and ventilate area for at least 30 minutes Repeat as desired or when necessary Do not place activated fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, sparks or open

flame

DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
