# ROSES, FLOWERS & ORNAMENTALS

To kill Aphids, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Whiteflies, Gypsy Moth Caterpillars and Adults, Tent Caterpillars and Adult Japanese Beetles.

WHERE TO USE: Use on African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, dogwood, geraniums, gladioli, marigolds, roses, rubber plants and wandering Jew. For house plants (African violets, begonias, geraniums, etc.) remove plants from house prior to treating.

HOW TO USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING! For best results, use throughout the growing season to prevent buildup of insect infestations. Spray plants from a distance of 1½-2 feet, using short bursts of 1 second. To prevent possible injury to sensitive plants, avoid visibly wetting the foliage. Apply in the early morning or late evening when air is still, treating all foliage with particular attention to the underside of leaves. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment every 7-10 days, or as reinfestation occurs.

#### **VEGETABLES**

To kill Asparagus Beetles, Aphids, Leafhoppers, Whiteflies, Mexican Bean Beetles, 12-spotted Cucumber Beetles, Cabbage Loopers, Cross-stripped Cabbage Worms, Diamondback Moth Caterpillars, Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bugs, Imported Cabbage Worms, Stink Bugs, Green Peach Aphids, Leaftiers, Fireworms, Leafhoppers, Blister Beetles, Colorado Potato Beetles, Webworms, Japanese Beetles.

WHERE TO USE: Use on asparagus, beans, broccoli, cabbage, Brussels sprouts, cauliflower, celery, cranberries, cucumbers, melons, squash, eggplants, lettuce, mustard greens, kale, collards, turnips, peppers, potatoes, radishes, spinach, sweet corn and tomatoes.
