

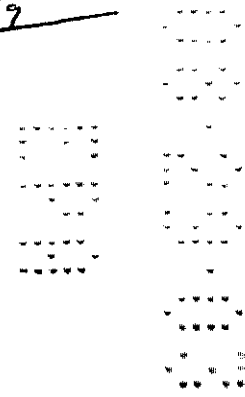

FIRST AID

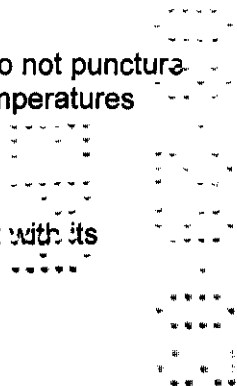

ROSES, FLOWERS & ORNAMENTALS

To kill **Aphids, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Whiteflies, Gypsy Moth Caterpillars and Adults, Tent Caterpillars and Adult Japanese Beetles.**

WHERE TO USE: Use on African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, dogwood, geraniums, gladioli, marigolds, roses, rubber plants and wandering Jew. For **house plants** (African violets, begonias, geraniums, etc.) remove plants from house prior to treating.

VEGETABLES
