**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not place on stove or radiator. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting. Do not apply this product in conduits/motor housings, junction and switch boxes of electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Do not use on surfaces that can be harmed or stained by water.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**INDOORS**

Spray to kill flying indoor insect pests such as Houseflies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees, Black Flies, Skipper Flies, Blow Flies and Small Flying Moths. Kills crawling indoor insect pests such as Ants, Bedbugs, Carpet Beetles, Clothes Moths, Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs.

**WHERE TO USE:** Use in homes, apartments, garages, and other indoor residential areas to control listed insect pests. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

**HOW TO USE:**

**FLYING INSECTS** - Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

**CRAWLING INSECTS** - Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets,

along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, contacting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary. To kill **Ants**, spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray directly on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary. To kill **Carpet Beetles** spray directly on floors, baseboards, carpets, and on beetles, where possible. Repeat treatment as necessary. To kill **Bedbugs** spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary. To control **Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles** on wool and other fibers, remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Treat infested articles by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storage areas, directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices.

**OUTDOORS**

Spray to kill outdoor flying insects such as **Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Hornets and Yellow Jackets**. To kill outdoor crawling insect pests such as **Ants, Clover Mites, Cockroaches (including Asian Cockroaches), Crickets, Mole Crickets, Centipedes, Earwigs, Fleas, Lone Star Ticks, Millipedes, Sowbugs (Pillbugs) and Silverfish**.

**WHERE TO USE:** Use outdoors around the home on the outside surfaces of buildings, on porches, patios, garages, garbage cans, and on ornamental plants and flowers to control listed insect pests.

**HOW TO USE:** Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

**PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS** - Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance, up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surface of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to) screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and garbage cans. Repeat treatment as necessary.

**FLYING INSECTS** - Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles. Repeat as necessary.

**CRAWLING INSECTS** - Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, contacting as many insects as possible. To repel ants, spray legs of tables and chairs. Spray ant trails and hills. To kill **Ants, Lone Star Ticks, Crickets, Fleas and Earwigs** apply thoroughly to infestations in bushes, grass or weeds.

**ORNAMENTAL GARDENS & FLOWERS**

Kills **Japanese Beetles** on contact. Kills **Aphids, Armyworms, Clover Mites, Exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Leafminers, Pavement Ants, Red Mites, Spiders, and Whiteflies**.

**WHERE TO USE:** Use on **African Violets, Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Camellias, Carnations, Chrysanthemums, Crassula, Dahlias, Geraniums, Grape Vine, Kentia Palm, Laurel, Marigolds, Rhododendrons, Roses, Rubber Plants, Snapdragons, Stocks, Wandering Jews, Zinnias, and other** ornamentals.

**HOW TO USE:** Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Spray in one-second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90° F. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as infestations occur.
