

DISINFECTS — DEODORIZES

WADING AND SWIMMING POOLS. To sanitize and prevent growth of algae, add 1 tablespoon or ½ ounce WHITE MONDAY for each 100 gallons of water. For 500 gallon pool, use 2 ounces. Maintain chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1 ppm. Use test kit. Maintain pH (acidity-alkalinity) of the water according to recommendations of local Public Health Authority.

DOUBTFUL DRINKING WATER: Sanitize by adding 10 drops WHITE MONDAY to each gallon clear water, free of visible dirt. Kills typhoid bacteria.

DISINFECTANT FOR BAR AND RESTAURANT GLASSES: Wash thoroughly. Let stand several seconds in solution of 2 tablespoons, or 1 ounce of WHITE MONDAY per gallon water. Apply a potable water rinse prior to use. We repeat, wash first.

GARBAGE CANS: Destroys odors; wash out can with 2 or 3 gallons of water containing a cupful of WHITE MONDAY. Rinse out with hose.

REFRIGERATOR: To sweeten and deodorize, wash with ½ cup WHITE MONDAY to a gallon of water. Rinse with clear water.

SINK, DRAINBOARD, ENAMELED SURFACES: To whiten use ½ cup WHITE MONDAY to a quart of water. Wash on. Rinse with water in 5 minutes.


BASEMENT AND SINK DRAINS: To deodorize, flush with ½ cup WHITE MONDAY to a quart of water.

TOILET BOWLS: To remove stains and odors: pour 1 cupful into bowl; swish solution over inside surface; add 2 tablespoonfuls of vinegar; let stand 1 hour or overnight.

WADING AND SWIMMING POOLS. To sanitize and prevent growth of algae, add 1 tablespoon of 5 percent WHITE MONDAY for each 100 gallons of water. For 500 gallon pools, use 2 ounces. Maintain chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1 ppm. Use test kit. Maintain pH (acidity-alkalinity) of the water according to recommendations of local Public Health Authority.

DOUBTFUL DRINKING WATER: Sanitize by adding 10 drops WHITE MONDAY to each gallon clear water, free of visible dirt. Kills typhoid bacteria.

DISINFECTANT FOR BAR AND RESTAURANT GLASSES: Wash thoroughly. Let stand several seconds in solution of 2 tablespoons, or 1 ounce of WHITE MONDAY per gallon water. Apply a potable water rinse prior to use. We repeat, wash first.

SINK, DRAINBOARD, ENAMELED SURFACES: To whiten use 1/2 cup WHITE MONDAY to a quart of water. Wash on. Rinse with water in 5 minutes.

BASEMENT AND SINK DRAINS: To deodorize, flush with 1/2 cup WHITE MONDAY to a quart of water.

TOILET BOWLS: To remove stains and odors: pour 1 cupful into bowl; swish solution over inside surface; add 2 tablespoonfuls of vinegar; let stand 1 hour or overnight.

WASHING DIRECTIONS

MILDEW STAINS AND SCORCH: Wash out starch, then mix 3 table-
spoonfuls of WHITE MONDAY to a quart of lukewarm water. Mix
well, immerse article completely. Let stand 15 minutes. Rinse well.

RUST can not be removed with bleach. Use pure vinegar or lemon
juice.

DO NOT USE ON SILK OR WOOL: The new synthetic fabrics, such as,
Nylon, Dacron, Orlon, Dynel, Rayon, and mixtures or blends of
these materials, may be safely, gently, and effectively bleached by
carefully following this method: to each gallon of water, cold or
warm, add 2 tablespoons WHITE MONDAY and 1 teaspoon baking
soda. Mix, and immerse fabric for 15 minutes. Rinse thoroughly.

WASHING DIRECTIONS FOR WHITE AND FAST COLORED COTTON, LINEN AND NYLON

IN WASHING MACHINE: WHITE MONDAY works equally well in
standard or automatic washers and does NOT harm the porcelain
lining, metal parts, rubber or glass. WHITE MONDAY works fine
with the modern sudsing detergents as well as with soap. Use 1/2
cup WHITE MONDAY to each 5 gallons suds or to each batch.
Add WHITE MONDAY and soap, or detergent, to water and mix
before putting in clothes. If your automatic requires putting in
clothes before water, dilute WHITE MONDAY in half-gallon of
water before adding. WHITE MONDAY gives added whiteness,
besides deodorizing and sanitizing.

COLORED CLOTHES: After finishing white clothes, colored clothes, if
fast colors, may be safely washed in the same water, as bleach
action is used up by each batch.

BABY CLOTHES, DIAPERS, BEDDING: Use WHITE MONDAY as
above. Boiling unnecessary. Rinse thoroughly. Removes stains,
deodorizes, sanitizes.
