BLEACH & DISINFECTANT

USE ON WHITE 100% NYLON, DACRON, RAYON

AS WELL AS ON COTTON AND LINEN.

DO NOT USE ON SILK OR WOOL USE ONLY ON FAST COLORS

IN THE LAUNDRY FOR TUB OR AUTOMATIC WASHER...Use 1 tablespoon Bleach for each gal. water.

In suds...Add Bleach...Add soap or detergent. Soak laundry for 1/4 hour to overnight, wash and rinse. For washers add Bleach, well diluted, after laundry is immersed.

In first rinse after washing...Add Bleach...mix well...let laundry soak 15 minutes, rinse thoroughly.

To whiten yellowed or gray 100% Nylon, Dacron or Rayon...Mix 2 tablespoons Bleach with 1 gal. warm water. Immerse clean fabric 15 to 30 minutes in this solution. Rinse well. Repeat if necessary.

Wash-and-Wear Fabrics...Follow bleaching instructions of fabric manufacturer.

To remove stains...Ink, dye, medicine, wine, coffee, tea, chocolate, grass, fruit, also scorch and mildew. Soak fabric in cold water 10 minutes. Then immerse in thoroughly mixed solution of 2 tablespoons Bleach for each quart cold water for 5 to 15 minutes. Rinse well in clear water.

AS A HOME DISINFECTANT, DEODORANT, CLEANER...Wash object thoroughly. Then immerse or keep wet for 5 minutes in solution of 3 tablespoons Bleach to each quart of hot water; rinse, dry. Recommended for dishes, porcelain bath tubs and sinks, basins, ranges, refrigerators, pots and pans; sick room, rubber sheets, bed pans, sputum cups, etc.

Toilet Bowls...Pour 1 cupful Bleach into bowl...swish well over all the inside surfaces, add 2 tablespoons vinegar. Let stand overnight.

Floors, tile linoleum...1 cup Bleach to gal. warm water. Wash well. Mop dry.

Wood bleach...Wash wood with hot suds. Apply solution 1/2 pt. Bleach to gal. warm water. Let soak 5 to 15 minutes. Rinse. Dry. Repeat if necessary.

Drain pipes, showers, basin, tubs...Flush with boiling water and follow with 1 cupful Bleach.

Garbage cans...Wash with hot suds...Rinse, then wash with solution of 3 tablespoons Bleach for each qt. water. Let stand 5 to 10 minutes — rinse and dry.

Dentures...To cleanse and disinfect. Immerse overnight in solution of 8 drops Bleach to 1/2 glass of water, rinse well.

Disinfecting solution (200 parts per million available chlorine)... Add 1 oz. (2 tablespoons) Bleach to each 2 gal. water. Mix well. Recommended by many Health Depts. for disinfecting thoroughly cleansed surfaces in Taverns, Restaurants, Soda Fountains, Dairies, etc.

Drinking water...To guard against bacterial contamination, mix thoroughly 1 drop Bleach in gal. of water. Let stand 5 minutes.
