DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SURFACE DISINFECTION: Walls, floors, tables, equipment, utensils - wash with solution containing 2 ounces "CONTROL" per gallon of water after cleaning.

DISINFECTION IN: Hospitals - Nursing Homes - Institutions - Walls, floors, non porous surfaces - use 2 ounces "CONTROL" per gallon of water after cleaning.

For porous and heavily contaminated surfaces, use 4 ounces "CONTROL" per gallon of water after cleaning.

For sheets, linens, aprons, uniforms, and other fabrics, soak in solution containing 2 ounces "CONTROL" per gallon of water.

CAUTION: "CONTROL" Disinfectant may cause skin irritation or damage to the eyes. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not take internally. In case of contact, flush immediately with plenty of water. For eyes, get medical attention. Avoid contamination of food.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GERMICIDAL FOGGING: Use standard cleaning and disinfecting procedures. Then treat inaccessible surfaces and objects by fogging unoccupied rooms with a solution of 5 ounces CONTROL to one gallon of germicidal solution in 15 minutes in a nondirectional, rotating spray. One gallon suffices for the average sick-room; use proportional quantities for smaller and larger spaces. Fogger should be placed in the center of the room on a turntable rotating at about 3 rpm. The nozzle of the fogger should be pointed upwards and both fogger and turntable should be placed on a 30-36" table. Allow a minimum of 15 minutes after fogging has stopped before entering the room.

FOR GENERAL USE

Use 2 ounces CONTROL per gallon of water - gives a 400 ppm. solution that can be used as a space deodorizing spray or surface wash.

4 ounces CONTROL per gallon of water gives a 1000 ppm solution that can be used for disinfecting and deodorizing when applied to surfaces, as well as providing air-deodorization when sprayed into the air.
