



NOTE TO USER: Do not use this product indoors - for exterior use only. Do not treat wood intended for indoor use. Keep product away from domestic animals. This product should not be used on any previously painted or sealed surface. It can be used over "weathered" stained but still porous surfaces. Do not use this product on wood intended for food, feed or potable water contact service. This product is not intended for below ground use or wood in contact with ground.

THE SURFACE: Wood to be treated with Cabot's #3800 should be seasoned dry, have bark removed, be free of paint, wax or other coatings, and mildew. Do not use adjacent to fresh stucco and do not use in intense heat.

APPLICATION: Apply a generous coat of Cabot's Clear Wood Preservative by brushing, spraying, or dipping. Allow at least 24 hours for drying before applying oil base paint. Allow 6-12 months before coating with latex paints or clear finishes. When dipping, allow the wood to be immersed for five minutes. Apply two coats of #3800, an hour apart, to wood that will not be covered with paint or other coatings.

Cabot's Clear Wood Preservative allows sunlight to "weather" wood naturally. The degree and shade of color change will vary with the exposure and the type of wood.

Treated lumber or fabric should be allowed to dry thoroughly... before using near plants.

COVERING CAPACITY: Approximately 300-400 square feet per gallon depending on wood porosity and surface conditions.

These stains are in compliance with the requirements of the California Air Resource Board Model Rule for Architectural Coating. Also complies with the Philadelphia Air Management Regulation V-Non-Photochemically Reactive.
