TERAMINE when tested by the A.O.A.C. Method, is guaranteed to have:

A phenol coefficient of 20 against Salmonella typhosa.

A phenol coefficient of 25 against Staphylococcus aureus—pus germs.

A phenol coefficient of 10 against Escherichia coli.

Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DIRECTIONS FOR GENERAL DISINFECTION:

Use PINE SCENTED TERAMINE in a dilution of 2½ ounces to 5 gallons of water for previously cleaned non-porous surfaces and 5 ounces to 5 gallons for previously cleaned porous surfaces. Thoroughly wet surfaces by wiping, mopping or scrubbing. An odorless detergent such as WESTOLITE® may be used for cleaning.

All floors, walls, outer surfaces of equipment, locker rooms, lockers, exterior toilet bowl surfaces, toilet seats and washrooms, should be disinfected with the recommended solution of PINE SCENTED TERAMINE.

PINE SCENTED TERAMINE will not deteriorate upon storage or after being frozen. Do not dilute or store PINE SCENTED TERAMINE in Iron, Galvanized Iron or in Tin Containers. Do not mix with soap.

OPERATIONAL DIRECTIONS:

(a) Empty residual beverages and food from all utensils before washing in detergent solution.

(b) Clean with adequate detergent solution such as DISHTERGENT, one half to one ounce per gallon water, with or without brushes. Rinse in clear water.

(c) Rinse for at least two minutes in a sanitizing solution, consisting of ½ ounce PINE SCENTED TERAMINE to 1 gallon of water.

(d) Remove from sanitizing solution. Rinse with potable water.
Operational directions may be altered to comply with local and State Public Health Regulations.

NOTE: Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
