DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

FOR GENERAL CLEANING: Mix two ounces (four tablespoonfuls) of SAVOPINE to one gallon of warm water for mopping, scrubbing, cleaning and sprinkling floors, walls, and cellars in office buildings, restaurants, mills, schools, etc.

FOR DISINFECTING: Mix one and one-half ounces (three tablespoonfuls) of SAVOPINE to one gallon of warm water and apply to the previously cleaned surface.

SINKS AND WASH BASINS: Scrub above and beneath units with a solution of two ounces (four tablespoonfuls) of SAVOPINE to one gallon of warm water. Then wash out with the same solution, pouring the remainder into the drain pipe.

WATER CLOSETS AND URINALS: The seat and floor around the water closets and urinals should be scrubbed regularly with a solution of two ounces (four tablespoonfuls) of SAVOPINE to one gallon of warm water.

After cleaning, to deodorize flush the closet and urinal bowls with a solution allowing it to remain in the bowl for a short time.

GARBAGE CANS: As a deodorant, thoroughly soak with a SAVOPINE solution, two ounces (four tablespoonfuls) to one gallon of warm water. Rinse the empty can with some of the solution and leave the wash in the can.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. May cause skin and eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes and on skin. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. If eye irritation persists, get medical attention. Avoid contamination of food.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
