B. Cold disinfection of surgical instruments — sterilization by autoclave should be performed wherever possible. Cold disinfection of surgical instruments with this material may be used as an emergency alternate. In the absence of heat, immerse in 2% solution for at least 10 minutes after removing excess soil by cleaning.

3. PRECAUTION: To disinfect RUBBER and PLASTIC objects, swab surfaces if possible. Immerse only if required. LIMIT EXPOSURE TO 10 MINUTES. PROLONGED IMMERSION IN DISINFECTANT MAY AFFECT PLASTICS AND RUBBER SERIOUSLY.
