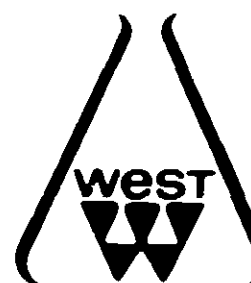

## Cleaning and Disinfecting B

Building surfaces and equipment, shovels and brooms with  
**WHITE PAK DISINFECTANT.**

Dissolve one packet in 1 gallon of water to make 3 gallons.

Remove gross filth and then scrub surfaces liberally. Scrub with a stiff brush. Rinse the surfaces for 5 to 10 minutes with water. Then be rinsed with potable water. **WHITE PAK DISINFECTANT** solution.

## Shoe Bath:

Dissolve 4 packets in 3 gallons of water.

## Sow Scrub:

Dissolve 2 packets in 3 gallons of water. Scrub flanks and udders with solution.

## DANGER:

Corrosive. Causes severe eye irritation. Get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear gloves when handling. Contamination of food.

**First Aid:** In case of contact with eyes, flush with water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing before drinking large quantities of fluid. Dispose of empty packets in a safe manner.

## Cleaning and Disinfecting Buildings and Equipment:

Building surfaces and equipment such as walls, floors, troughs, feed-handling equipment, shovels and buckets should be cleaned and disinfected with WHITE PAK DISINFECTANT.

Dissolve one packet in 1 gallon of water and stir for 1 minute. Add water to make 3 gallons.

Remove gross filth and then apply the WHITE PAK DISINFECTANT solution liberally. Scrub with a stiff bristle brush and allow the solution to remain on the surfaces for 5 to 10 minutes. Rinse. All feed-handling equipment should be rinsed with potable water after being cleaned or disinfected with WHITE PAK DISINFECTANT solution.

## Shoe Bath:

Dissolve 4 packets in 3 gallons of water. Place shoe bath inside doorway.

## Sow Scrub:

Dissolve 2 packets in 3 gallons of lukewarm water. Prior to farrowing, scrub flanks and udders with solution, using soft brush. Rinse.

## DANGER:

Corrosive. Causes severe eye damage. Causes severe skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shields and rubber gloves when handling concentrate. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**First Aid:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before re-use. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of fluid and call a physician immediately.

Dispose of empty packets in a safe place.
