NORINQUA is a cleaner, disinfectant and sanitizer for use on washable walls, floors and inanimate hard surfaces. When used as directed, NORINQUA will also deodorize those areas which generally are hard to keep odor free, and which are prone to odors caused by the growth of some microorganisms. NORINQUA has a phenol coefficient of 13 against *S. typhosa* and 20 against *S. aureus*. NORINQUA is effective at 2 ounces per gallon when tested against the organisms, *S. aureus*, and *S. cholerae*, and at 3 ounces per gallon against *P. aeruginosa*.

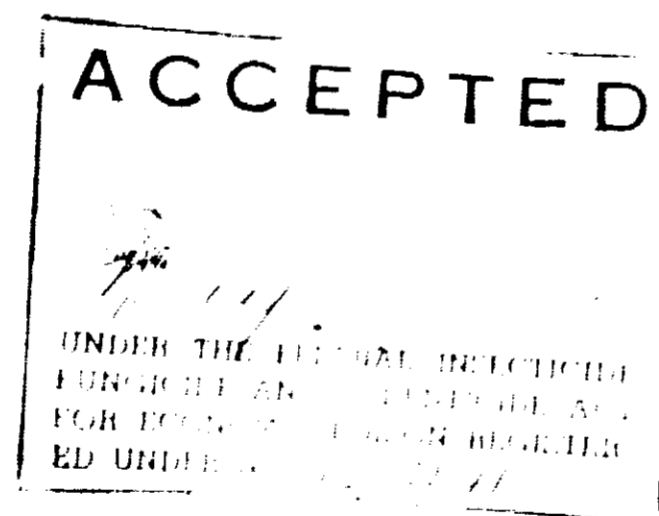
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To clean and disinfect most surfaces, use 2 or 3 ounces of NORINQUA per gallon of water. Apply liberally using a mop, cloth or sponge.

For cleaning and disinfecting in and around toilet bowls, urinals, sinks, fixtures, etc., use 3 ounces of NORINQUA per gallon of water. 2 ounces per gallon will provide 500 ppm quaternaries. This is enough for general disinfection, fungicidal activity against pathogenic fungi and deodorizing.

For use in hospitals, 3 ounces per gallon of water will be required for disinfection against *P. aeruginosa*.

NET CONTENTS:

SANITIZATION

When used for sanitization of previously cleaned food processing and food contact items, limit the active quaternaries to 200 ppm (4 ounces per 5 gallons of water). At this level, NO POTABLE WATER RINSE IS REQUIRED.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

KEEP FROM FREEZING.

FIRST AID
