Purpose

The purpose of this submission is to request three (3) label changes and one (1) formula change, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act

(FIFRA).

Review

We have reviewed your request to make the changes indicated above and have the following comments:

1. Addition of 4oz and 2 lb Packages

This amendment is acceptable, provided that you add the qualifying statement for the 4 oz package, as show below.

2. Revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF)

Your revised CSF is unacceptable because it varies in significant ways from the one that we accepted previously (September 5, 2003), which you had previous associated with data under MRID No. 452072-01. You need to use the 2003 formula or submit efficacy data to support the new formula.

Label

The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product.

1. Under the "APPLICATION DIRECTIONS", revise the qualifying statements to read as follows:

For Rats: For the 4 oz. size: This package contains enough bait to kill one (1) to two (2) rats.

For Rats: For the 8 oz. size: This package contains enough bait to kill

two (2) to four (4) rats.

For Rats: For the 12 oz. size: This package contains enough bait to

kill three (3) to six (6) rats.

Existing stocks

Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

Consequence for non-compliance

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help prevent accidents:

- 1. Store product not in use. In a location out of reach of children and

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS

Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. For best results, remove as much foodstuff, as possible, from the area to be baited.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

For Rats: For the 8 oz. size: This package contains enough bait to kill two (2) to seven (7) rats.

For the 12 oz. size: This package contains enough bait to kill three (3) to seven (7) rats.

For Rats: apply 2 to 8 blocks (4 to 16 oz. of bait) per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.

For Mice: While wearing waterproof gloves break each 2 oz. block into 3 pieces and place 1 or 2 pieces at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 3 pieces (2 oz.) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

 Follow up:: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and any left-over bait property. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborages as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish with fresh bait as often as needed.
