Label review The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product.

- Since you have combined your emergency information together in your "FIRST AID" section, including the section "EMERGENCY INFORMATION" appears to be redundant.
- 2. You need "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" texts for household and non-household sizes. See Enclosure 1.

A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

Existing stocks

Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

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Enclosure 1. Storage and Disposal Texts for EPA Reg. No. 56-58

A. Household Sizes (1 lb)

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse empty container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

B. Household Sizes

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.



For control of Norway Rats, Roof Rats, House Mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings and similar man made structures. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food, water, or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS

Determine areas where rats and mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

The amount of bait in one 4 ounce place pack of this product is unlikely to be sufficient to kill more than one or two rats.

For Rats: Apply 1 to 4 place packs (4 to 16 oz. of bait) per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.

• For Mice: Open pack, while wearing gloves, and apply 1/4 to 1/2 ounce of bait at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 ounces), may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

• For Rats and Mice: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and any leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit as many sources of food, water, and harborages as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish with fresh bait as often as needed. 07-29-03
