DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is designed for both homeowners and professionals and gives fast effective insect control when powder is dry or even when it becomes moist or wet.

A FLEA POWDER FOR YOUR PETS
For control of Fleas, Ticks and Lice on Dogs, Cats and Pets sprinkle the dust over the back line of the pet and rub into the hair at the neck, ears, and rump until dust reaches pet's skin. Dust the belly, chest and neck and the insides of legs. Inspect ears, etc. for presence of Ticks and directly dust any that may be present. Do not get dust into pet's eyes or mouth. Dust pet sleeping quarters and replace with fresh bedding. Lightly "Puff" dust on to fresh bedding to deposit a barely visible thin film of residual dust for continued control. Repeat treatment as needed.

HOME / RESIDENTIAL PEST CONTROL
Shake the container/applicator of EATON'S ANSWER II vigorously to fluff the dust. To apply, remove lid and squeeze/puff the dust through the perforated cap.

GENERAL USE AREAS
May be applied in Homes, Motels/Hotels, Apartments, Condominiums, Restaurants, Offices, Warehouses, Factories, Theaters, Kennels, Hospitals (non-occupied patient areas), Nursing Homes (non-occupied patient areas), Food and Feed producing establishments, Attics, Crawl Spaces, Basements, Garages.
