PET POWDER Dogs & Cats Only.

For control of Fleas, Ticks and Lice on Dogs, and Cats only, sprinkle the dust over the back line of the pet and rub into the hair at the neck, ears, and rump until dust reaches pet's skin. Dust the belly, chest and neck and the insides of legs. Inspect ears, etc. for presence of Ticks and directly dust any that may be present. Do not get dust into pet's eyes or mouth.
