Purpose The purpose of this submission is to revise your label in accordance with PR Notices 2001-1 and 2001-6 and make other labeling changes.

Label review The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product.

1. No text on your label may be less than 6 Point, including the text under the American flag. See Enclosure 1 for minimum size requirements.
2. Revise your "FIRST AID" text according to Enclosure 2.
3. Revise your "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" according to Enclosure 3.

A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

Existing stocks Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

Consequence for non-compliance If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Enclosure 3. Storage and Disposal Text for EPA Reg. No. 56-69**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: **If empty:** Do not reuse empty container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL. Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use, in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals, and nontarget wildlife or in "tamper-resistant" bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS

THIS IS NOT A TAMPER-PROOF OR TAMPER-RESISTANT BAIT STATION. DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT IN AREAS ACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN, PETS DOMESTIC ANIMALS, OR NONTRAGET WILDLIFE. DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT OUTDOORS.

This product may be used to control Norway Rats (*Ratus norvegicus*), Roof Rats (*Rattus rattus*), and House Mice (*mus musculus*) in homes, and in industrial, commercial, or agricultural buildings. Do not place feeder boxes in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food, water, or surfaces that come in direct contact with either.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS

Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, beside burrows, inside buildings, or in corners and concealed places.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

The amount of bait in one 4 ounce Feeder Box of this product is unlikely to be sufficient to kill more than 1 or 2 rats.

• **For Rats:** Place 1 to 4 feeder boxes at intervals of 15 to 20 feet along walls or in corners where rats or signs of rats have been seen.

• **For Mice:** Place single feeder boxes at intervals of 8 to 12 feet along walls or in corners where mice or signs of mice have been seen.

• **For Rats and Mice:** Replace feeder boxes if their contents have been consumed or contaminated, or if the units are severely damaged. Units not touched after three days should be moved to new locations where rat or mice activity is evident and units can be placed without violating the requirements of this label.

Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborages as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment.
