Label review The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide,

(1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship

your product.

1. Add the "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN" at the end of your "FIRST AID" section. See enclosure 1.

2. You need "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" texts for household and non-household sizes. See Enclosure 2.

3. Capitalize or italicize the scientific names of the target organisms. Change "Ratus" to "Rattus", and change "mus" to "Mus.

A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Store product not in use. In a location out of reach of children and pets.
- 2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals, and nontarget wildlife or in "tamper-resistant" bait stations These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait Manufactured in U.S.A. can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise Immobilized. This product may be used to control Norway Rats (Ratus norvegicus), Roof Rats (Rattus rattus), and House Mice (mus. musculus in homes, and in industrial, commercial, or agricultural buildings. Do not place feeder boxes in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food, water, or surfaces that come in direct contact with either.

#### SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS

Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, beside burrows, inside buildings, or in corners and concealed places.

## APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

The amount of bait in one 4 ounce Feeder Box of this product is unlikely to be sufficient to kill more than 1 or 2 rats.

• For Rats: Apply 1 to 4 feeder Boxes (4 to 16 oz. of bait) per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.

• For Mice: Open Feeder box, while wearing gloves, and apply 1/4 to 1/2 ounce of bait at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 ounces may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

 For Rats and Mice: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and any left-over bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit as many sources of food, water, and harborages as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish with fresh bait as often as needed, of-26-04
