IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help prevent accidents:

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS

Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, beside burrows, inside buildings, or in corners and concealed places.

The amount of bait in one 4 ounce Feeder Box of this product is unlikely to be sufficient to kill more than 1 or 2 rats. • For Rats: Apply 1 to 4 feeder Boxes (4 to 16 oz. of bait) per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.


 For Mice: Open Feeder box, while wearing gloves, and apply 1/4 to 1/2 ounce of bait at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 ounces may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

 For Rats and Mice: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and any left-over bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit as many sources of food, water, and harborages as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish with fresh bait as often as needed. 08-13-08
