**Purpose** The purpose of this submission is to add a new use, chipmunks, to the label of this product, under section 3 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA).

**Labeling** The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you

A. submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product:

1. After "READ THIS LABEL", add this 2<sup>nd</sup> Sentence: "Use only for the sites, pests, and application methods described on this label."
2. Revise your "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" according to Enclosure 1.

**Labeling-continued**

3. Revise your "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD" text as follows:

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD**

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Dogs and other predatory and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten the bait. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

- 4. The text of the Ingredient Statement must run parallel with other text on the panel [40 CFR 156.10(g)(2)(i)].
- 5. Revise your "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" text according to Enclosure 2.
- 6. Submit both your Outer Label and Place Pack labels containing the Chipmunk use, which should be identical and labeling for the "Mouse Only" product. If you have a "Warranty" or "Disclaimer" statement, include those texts.

B. within two (2) years of the date of this acceptance, submit acceptable supporting efficacy data in accordance with our previously sent (February 1, 2007) product performance review of September 11, 2006

**Existing stocks**

Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

**Consequence for non-compliance**

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a ... with its labeling.

**Norway Rats Roof Rats, and House Mice**

**USE RESTRICTIONS** ... spoiled bait immediately. Using water-proof gloves, collect and dispose ... often as needed.

**Chipmunks**

**USE RESTRICTIONS**

For control of Chipmunks around the foundations of homes and other buildings and adjacent patios, walls, and walkways where burrowing activity of these animals are compromising these structures by removal of soil and exposure to precipitation and weather. **Use only in Tamper-Resistant Bait Stations. See description above.**

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS**

Determine areas where Chipmunks will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are adjacent to burrow entrances and along burrow runways.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS**

For a minor infestation (1 to 3 animals) in one area, use a single tamper-resistant bait station. Place 1 to 3 place packs of this product on a **Securing Rod** (available from Eaton) inside of the bait station. Place bait station beside burrow or on runway and secure bait station to the ground with Eaton’s **“Securing Stake”, or other means, to insure that bait station will not be moved or picked up.**

For more extensive infestations, use additional tamper-resistant bait stations, no closer than 20 feet.

Check stations (daily, if possible) and maintain bait for a minimum of 10 days or until activity stops, determined by absence of plugged burrows and absence of fresh signs of animals. Using water-proof gloves, collect and properly dispose of spilled bait and dead animals, whenever found. Remove bait stations at end of control program.

If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hooved livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

### USE RESTRICTIONS

For control of House Mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings and similar man made structures. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food, water, or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

### SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS

Determine areas where mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where mice or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much food as possible.

### APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

Apply one place pack per bait placement. Space place packs at intervals of 8 to 12 feet. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days. Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation occurs repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed. 03-29-04


