Do not use in milking stables, milking parlors, milk houses or dairy houses.

## Saponified Cresylic Solution

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZAROUS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Note to Physician: This is a saponified cresylic solution. It is a strong irritant. Measures should be taken to prevent further exposure. Do not use solvents or abrasives.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use only for disinfection of surfaces. Do not use on skin or clothing.

Dilution Rate: 1/4 to 1/2 ounce per gallon of water.

GENERAL DISINFECTION (Livestock) Solution: 1/2 ounce per gallon of water. Use for disinfecting surfaces, cages, and equipment. Do not use on animals.
