# Pine Oil Disinfectant

Pine Oil Disinfectant is made to the specifications of the "Commercial Standard C.S. 69-38" by National Bureau of Standards, Washington D.C.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

### Disinfecting and Cleaning

As a deodorant use 2 ounces ( $\frac{1}{4}$  cupful) in 3 gallons of water. If stronger odor is desired, use more to suit conditions.

For disinfecting, add water to the disinfectant at the rate of one gallon of Pine Oil Disinfectant to 90 gallons of water (1 $\frac{1}{2}$  ounces to 1 gallon of water). Stir well after adding water. This solution acts as an effective disinfectant.

### Use in Home, Sickroom and Kennels

Scrub or clean at a strength of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  ounces to 1 gallon of water or at the rate of one gallon of Pine Oil Disinfectant to 90 gallons of water—this makes an effective disinfectant and deodorant. If premises simply require sweetening, 2 ounces to 3 gallons is sufficient.

### Deodorant Sawdust

An excellent plan adopted by many kennels as well as Dog Shows is to mix one part Pine Oil Disinfectant with 20 parts water, then moisten sawdust with this solution. This

### Buildings, Schools, Factories

Scrub regularly with diluted Pine Oil Disinfectant mixed with water at the rate of 1 part to 90 parts water.

### Sinks, Urinals, Water Closets

Thoroughly scrub the places to be disinfected. Use 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  ounces to 1 gallon of water as a flush, or at dilution of 1 part Pine Oil Disinfectant to 90 parts of water. Allow solution to remain overnight where possible.

## WARNING

Pine Oil Disinfectant is a concentrated liquid and should be handled and diluted with care. Beware of splashing in eyes or on other mucous surfaces. Harmful if swallowed. If swallowed give raw egg white, milk, mucilage, rice gruel, or cornstarch paste. Call a physician immediately. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it. Do not use stronger than directed.


