The use of this product for treatment of other pests is prohibited. Applicators must wear the following protective clothing during the treatment process: elbow-length, waterproof gloves; a waterproof apron; and unlined, waterproof boots. Improper dilution of this product could cause serious injury to your pet. Children should not be allowed to handle or apply this product.

Never use a solution stronger than recommended.

Malathion is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Do not use Kil-A-Mite on animals simultaneously or within a few days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals. Consult a veterinarian at first signs of adverse reaction.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**If Swallowed:** Call a physician/veterinarian immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING, unless under medical supervision. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

**If On Skin:** Wash immediately with plenty of soap and water.

**If In Eyes:** Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water.

**Note to Physician/Veterinarian:** This product contains a chlorinated hydrocarbon, an organophosphate and petroleum distillates. ATROPINE IS ANTIDOTAL for the organophosphate ingredient only.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Keep out of any body of water.

**Sarcoptic Mange:** Stir four tablespoonfuls (2 fl. oz) of Kil-A-Mite into one gallon of water. Using a brush, wet dog thoroughly with this emulsion, making sure that mange scabs and lesions are penetrated. Allow dog to dry in a warm place, without rinsing or toweling. Repeat weekly until condition clears up.

**SHAKE OR STIR PRODUCT THOROUGHLY BEFORE USING OR REUSING DILUTED EMULSIONS.**

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. On page 2 of the draft labeling follow "Never use a solution stronger than recommended." with: "Improper dilution of this pesticide product could cause serious injury to your pet."
2. Revise the first sentence of the "If swallowed" STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT to read:  
"Call a physician/veterinarian or Poison Control Center immediately."
3. ~~Add an if inhaled statement as follows:  
"If inhaled-Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated."~~

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until May 1, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
