DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove protective cap. Hold container in upright position about one foot away from animal pointing valve opening toward animal. Release spray by pressing valve.

Spray in a zigzag motion so as to slightly dampen animal's coat. Spray all areas of animal with particular attention to legs and under belly, for best results.

For Face Flies spray to slightly dampen animal's face. Do not exceed one ounce per animal. Repeat as required.

Hair can be ridden or "worked" immediately after use.

CAUTION

Avoid personal contact, and use in a well-ventilated area. Do not contaminate feed.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.
