

DIRECTIONS

Dairy Cattle

To control Face Flies, dilute 1 1/2 gallons of water with 1/2 gallon of Cio-Rid. Spray proportionately for 14 days every seven days.

Loose Penned Cattle

To control Face Flies, dilute 1 1/2 gallons of water with 1/2 gallon of Cio-Rid. Spray adult animals and pens often than once every seven days.

Sheep, Goats and Swine

To control Stable Flies, dilute 1 gallon of water with 1/2 gallon of diluted Cio-Rid. Spray every seven days.

Back Rubbers

For control of Flies, dilute 1/2 gallon of Cio-Rid in 1 gallon of suitable oil. Charge back rubbers.

Surfaces

For control of House Flies, dilute 1/2 gallon of Cio-Rid in 1 gallon of water (1 to 14). Spray wet surfaces, but not in hog pens and other areas where Cio-Rid is prohibited (Cio-Rid) in poultry.
