##### Loose Penned and Feed Lot Cattle

Apply to the face, neck, and body of loose penned and feed lot cattle. Repeat as directed.

Sheep, Goats and Swine: Apply to the face, neck, and body of sheep, goats, and swine. Repeat as directed.

Back Rubbers: Apply to the back rubbers of dairy cattle. Dilute 1 part Cio-Rid with 2 1/2 gallons of water. Repeat as directed.

Surface Spray: Apply to the interior surfaces of dairy barns and other farm buildings. Dilute 1 part Cio-Rid with 1 gallon of water. Repeat as directed.
