### WIPE-ON INSECTICIDE DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label directions.

Wipe On Insecticide has been specifically developed for use on horses against flies while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed.

### TO WIPE-ON

First brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet) cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair on the legs, shoulders, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies most often bite.

Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on a horse. After application, brush thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat.

Repeat daily or as required.

### USE AS A SPRAY

Wipe On Insecticide may be applied as a fine mist or fog spray to stable animals for fast paralysis and kill of flies. **Do not wet animals skin.** Only use on horses.

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Do not spray on food. Remove or cover exposed foods before spraying. Do not apply to dairy animals.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**PROHIBITIONS** - Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Storage and disposal prohibited.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL** - Pesticide spray mixture or rinse liquids that remain in the container should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides. Do not discharge into water supplies.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL** - Reseal container and offer for reconditioning or offer for recycling, reconditioning or disposal in approved landfill or bury.

**GENERAL** - Consult Federal, State or local disposal authorities for approval.

### FIRST AID TREATMENT

Internal - **CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY** if swallowed. **DO NOT** induce vomiting. Seek medical supervision.

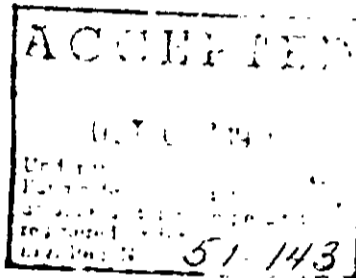
Human External - If on skin, wash with plenty of soap and water. If in eyes, wash with clear water for at least 15 minutes.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN/VETERINARIAN** - This product contains a chloroform distillate.

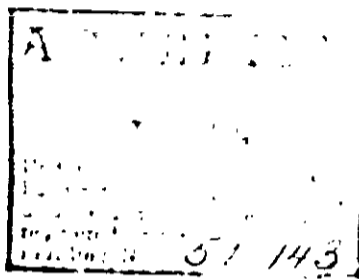

## WIPER ON INSECTICIDE DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a violation of Federal law if this product is used in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

Wiper On Insecticide has been registered for use on horses to provide a protective hair coating against flies while imparting a high gloss to the hair when dry.

### TO WIPER ON

First, brush animal to remove dirt and manure. Moisten animal coat wet to the point of dripping a soft cloth and rub over the hair to assist in applying to the surface of the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulders, snanks, neck and tail area where fly infestation are seen.

Only a light application is required. Avoid applying to eyes, nose and mouth of animals. **Do not wet skin.**

After application, brush thoroughly to bring out bright sheen in the coat.

Repeat daily or as required.

### USE AS A SPRAY

Wiper On Insecticide may be applied as a fine mist or fog spray to stable area and over and around stabled animals for fast paralysis and kill of flies. **Do not wet animals skin.** (Only a fine mist spray is required.)

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Do not spray this material on or near open flame. Remove or cover exposed foods before spraying. Do not spray directly at animals.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**PROHIBITIONS** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL** Pesticide spray material should be disposed of by incineration, or by other means. Reprocessed should be disposed of in a similar manner. Do not discharge into any waterway or water supply.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL** Repeat container and offer for recycling, or if not available, offer for recycling, reuse, or disposal in accordance with applicable State laws.

**GENERAL** Consult Federal, State or local disposal authorities for all hazardous material regulations.

### FIRST AID TREATMENT

**Internal** CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. SWALLOWED. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** Get medical supervision.

**Human External** Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Flush eyes with clean water for at least 15 minutes.
