PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING

Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing of dust and contact with skin. Wash after handling.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. Drink a glass of water and induce vomiting by administering syrup of ipecac or by touching back of throat with a finger.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if needed.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: This product contains an organophosphate. ATROPINE IS ANTIDOTAL.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS — Place the dog on a table or bench, preferably out of doors. Dust entire dog beginning at head, being careful to avoid pet's eyes and working back, being sure dust penetrates to the skin, especially around feet and legs. Each application remains active in the coat, killing fleas for up to 21 days and ticks for up to 14 days. Repeat as necessary.

TO CONTROL FLEAS IN INFESTED PREMISES — Fleas spend part of their life cycle off the dog, in dust beneath bedding or in cracks or crevices. Dust the dog's living quarters occasionally with Dermatol Dust.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
