DIRECTIONS FOR USE—GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product must be diluted before use.

Stir four tablespoonsfuls (2 fl. oz) of Expar 3.2% EC into one gallon of water. Dip, sponge or swab dog with this emulsion until thoroughly wet. Allow dog to dry in a warm place without rinsing or towel-drying.

Expar 3.2% EC gives long-lasting protection against reinestation, and applications at intervals of two or three weeks will control ticks, fleas and lice on dogs. Repeat application as required.

SHAKE OR STIR PRODUCT THOROUGHLY BEFORE USING OR REUSING DILUTED EMULSION

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in cool, dry place.

Pesticide Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not reuse empty bottle. Wrap bottle and put in trash.
