WARNING

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: CONSULT A PHYSICIAN OR POISON CONTROL CENTER IMMEDIATELY. NOTE: ATROPINE IS ANTIDOTAL. If swallowed, gastric lavage is indicated. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING, unless under medical supervision. Vomiting petroleum distillates may produce aspiration pneumonia. If vomiting occurs spontaneously DO NOT let victim lie down. DO NOT allow any material to enter the airway.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Artificial respiration or administration of oxygen may be lifesaving.

Note to Physician: 2-chloro-1-(2,4-dichlorophenyl) vinyl diethyl phosphate is a cholinesterase inhibitor and treatment of poisoning should include atropine.

Ticks and Fleas on Dogs: Thoroughly mix 1 fluid ounce (2 tablespoons) with one gallon of water. Bathe or dip dog, making sure dog is thoroughly wet. Repeat treatment if necessary but not more often than once a week. Use freshly prepared material. Wear rubber gloves while preparing dip and treating dog.

Ticks and Fleas in Yards, Kennels, Etc.: Mix at the rate of 1/2 fluid ounce (1 tablespoon) in one pint of water. Spray or sprinkle at the rate of one pint per 100 square feet of yard or kennel area. Do not treat areas occupied by unprotected humans. Wear rubber gloves while preparing and using dip.
SHAKE OR STIR DIP THOROUGHLY BEFORE USING OR REUSING DILUTED EMULSIONS.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL STATEMENT

Storage: Store in cool, dry place away from heat or open flame.

Pesticide Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse bottle. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
