For EPA Registration No. 59-205 under the Directions for Use, change the statement, "... and for dogs apply amount needed to thoroughly cover hair coat.", to "... and for dogs apply amount needed to evenly cover hair coats. Include hard to reach areas such as under the tail, chest, stomach and undersurface of the neck. Shield you pet's eyes with your hand while applying to the head area and be careful not to get inside the ears. OVERUSE.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the subject product labeling is enclosed for your records.


