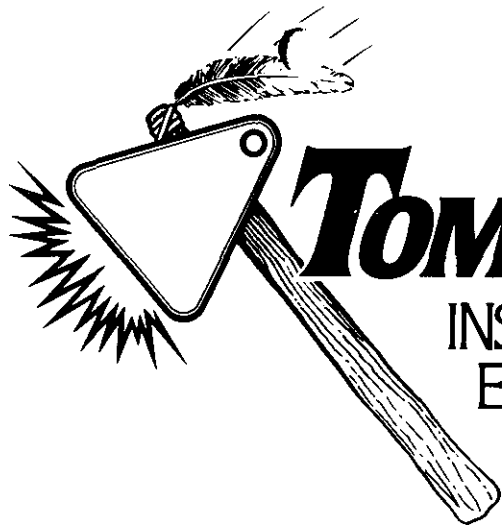

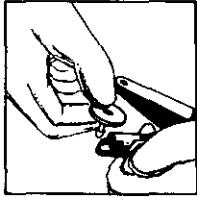

Place male button onto pin until it projects through the tip.

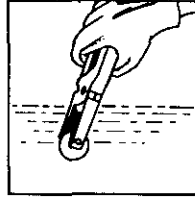

Dip tag button into disinfectant solution.

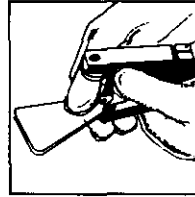

Press female tag under the clip by depressing lever.

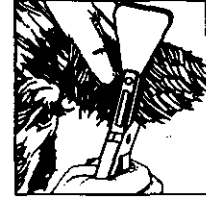
